Safety on the Frontlines of COVID-19

As a business on the frontlines of the COVID-19 pandemic, it was imperative for us to quickly adapt our safety measures and practices on our construction sites across the country. As a general contractor, we were tasked with not only keeping our employees, workers and partners safe, but also promoting health and safety in the communities surrounding our projects. This necessitated a strong network of communication so that information could travel quickly and efficiently from our company's leaders to our superintendents, field staff and subcontractors.

McShane's motto is, "Safety First, Last and Always," and while this is true at all times, pandemic or not, it has been especially important over the past four months.



Our team worked diligently to implement precautionary parameters on all of our sites. In addition to our normal safety program, the following protocols were put in place:

- Six-foot social distancing requirement
- 100% face covering requirement
- Hand washing required before entering the construction trailer
- Isolation of trade crews to avoid multiple teams working in the same area
- Employees required to report any signs of illness to on-site personnel
- Temperature checks with contactless thermometers
- Social-distanced outdoor or virtual meetings We are grateful to all of our employees, subcontractors, clients and partners who have showed continued support and dedication to the success of our projects throughout this time. We're especially grateful to our superintendents and other field staff who worked tirelessly to uphold our safety protocols while keeping our projects moving.

Bystronic Relocates North American HQ to New Facility in Hoffman Estates, Illinois

Bystronic's new Experience Center consists of 165,000 square feet of space to support its headquarters office, showroom, and manufacturing and warehouse operations. The Experience Center lets visitors see how Bystronic uses automation, digital networking and intelligent services to manufacture their sheet metal products.

The two-story office features 30,000 square feet of open and private offices and a café, while the 32' clear height showroom encompasses 28,500 square feet and a 1,500-square-foot mezzanine. The 102,800-square-foot warehouse and manufacturing area also features a 32' clear height and incorporates two 30-ton equipment cranes and four 20-ton equipment cranes.

Bystronic selected the 11.2-acre lot within the Huntington 90 business park because of its premier, high-visibility location.

WESTERN REGION

Construction Underway at Exciting New Office and Retail Development in Westwood, California

Located next to Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center in the heart of Westwood, 900 Gayley Avenue is designed with elements to match the surrounding area's historic architecture.

The steel frame and cast-in-place concrete structure will consist of four stories of office and retail space constructed over a three-story, underground parking structure with a brick, glass and metal panel exterior. The mixed-use development will feature 33,317 square feet of office space and 5,182 square feet of retail space.

The building will incorporate rooftop biofiltration planters, high ceilings, efficient lighting, state-of-the-art HVAC and sound insulation, making it a desirable, energy-efficient property for businesses.

McShane also performed site work for the project, including the demolition of an existing two-story building. Completion is slated for May 2021.

Leon Capital Group Selects McShane for Two Multi-Family Assignments in Arizona

McShane's Southwest Region is underway on two apartment projects for Leon Capital Group. Kierland Apartments is a 202-unit community in north Phoenix and Soltra at SanTan Village is a 380-unit development in Gilbert, Arizona.

Kierland Apartments will feature five stories of wood frame construction over a two-story concrete podium with one subgrade level. The exterior facade will consist of an attractive mix of stucco, stone and metal panels with wire and glass railings on the balconies.

Soltra at San Tan Village will feature one-, two- and three-bedroom configurations.

Early involvement enabled McShane to perform extensive preconstruction services, which included evaluating the most efficient MEP systems and determining cost-effective solutions for the building envelopes.

True Light Haven is an affordable senior living residence in Atlanta for National Church Residences. Units are offered in a mix of one- and two-bedroom floorplans. True Light Haven was designed to achieve National Green Building Standard (NGBS) Gold certification.

Originally constructed as an office building and abandoned in 2009, the 15-story structure was transformed into 134 high-end apartments and townhomes.



The 304-unit, luxury multi-family residence features five stories of wood frame construction wrapped around a six-story precast parking deck.



Located near Milwaukee, the four-story multi-family development incorporates 177 units, a club area, fitness center and rooftop patio.



Under construction for a notable e-commerce retailer, this 162,000-square-foot distribution facility is designed to accommodate 600 Sprinter vans.



Located in Chicago's Bronzeville neighborhood, the mixed-use development features 84 mixed-income apartments and 18,000 square feet of commercial space.



The 192-unit, luxury multi-family residence will incorporate 15 garden-style apartment buildings, a clubhouse and a swimming pool.



Uniquely designed, the four-building industrial development features a total of 470,000 square feet of space for advanced manufacturing and light industrial.

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
